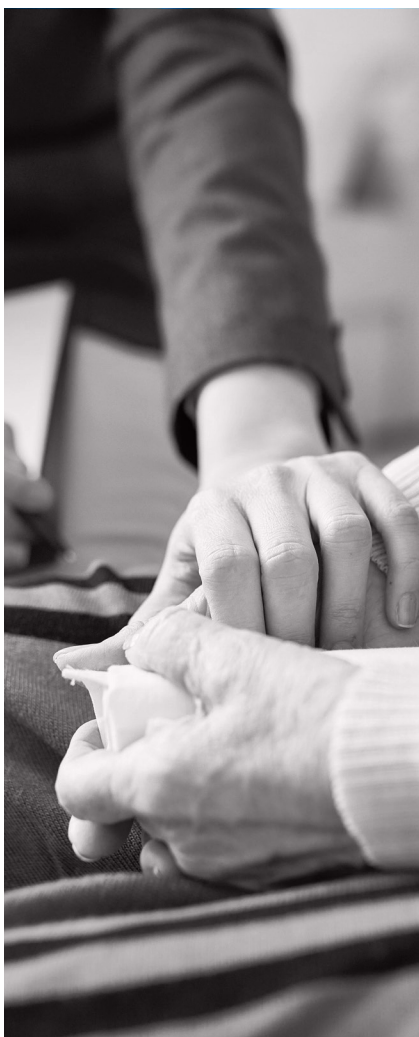




Our programs allow you to complete an advanced skill set certificate in one year or get your Associate Degree in two years.
